# INVINCIBLE Youth:

## How to Play a Vital Role in Developing Resilient Youth

**W**hether you work at a school, in juvenile justice, in the arts, in social services, or at a family resource center and whether you are a parent or a young person, this dynamic day will provide you with tools and inspiration to play a vital role in developing resilient young people.

Based on research which demonstrates the power of a strength-based approach to working with youth, the methods learned in this training can be integrated into your youth and/or coalition work without representing something more to do. Rather, this is a common sense approach to put new life into how you work with, and on the behalf, of teens. You will learn meaningful and measurable strategies, known as the Integrative Youth Development (IYD), which will provide you with processes and tools to:

- Create caring learning environments that increase student achievement
- Develop higher levels of satisfaction in youth/adult interactions
- Implement measurable and meaningful systems of care and connection
- Increase youth engagement and connection
- Learn a meaningful, memorable parable that can compel others (of all ages) to identify and build their personal village
- Decrease youth risk behaviors such as alcohol, tobacco, drug use and risky sexual behavior
